Dear Secretary Abraham:

The Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (Board) received your letter of September 14, 2001, transmitting the revised Implementation Plan for the Board's Recommendation 2001-1, *High-Level Waste Management at the Savannah River Site*.

The Board has reviewed the implementation plan and finds it to be responsive to Recommendation 2001-1 and consistent with the guidance provided in our letter of May 24, 2001. The Board agrees that commitments and schedules for the design, construction, and operation of a salt processing facility are best deferred until additional information becomes available. Additionally, the Board is encouraged to learn that the Department of Energy Savannah River Operations Office (DOE-SR) is pursuing new options to dispose of lower activity salt solutions on a significantly accelerated timetable.

Our staff will continue to stay in close contact with representatives of DOE-SR and the Office of Environmental Management to follow the progress in implementing Recommendation 2001-1.
