Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter documents Defense Programs (DP) response plans regarding the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (Board) letter of April 30, 2001, on the quality and adequacy of the authorization bases for the defense nuclear facilities at the Y-12 National Security Complex (Y-12). DP senior managers in Headquarters and at Y-12 met via teleconference on May 3, 2001, to plan our "path forward." Direction was given to prepare for a briefing to the Acting Deputy Administrator for Defense Programs (DP-1) by June 15, 2001, and a briefing for the Board by no later than June 30, 2001. The briefs will be structured to address the following:

- a) technical resource requirements and actions to address both the short-term and long-term periods;
- b) actions required and/or taken to address the integration of hazards identification and analysis at Y12; and,
- c) actions required and the status of correcting the individual technical issues contained within the letter and Board Staff issue report.
